

LOCATION MAPS





Currently, 52.4% of the 42,941 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 37.6%, renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 39,888 housing units in the area - 59.2% owner occupied, 33.3% renter occupied, and 7.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.33%. Median home value in the area is \$140,502, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.22% annually to \$156,837.
