The 512 Franklin home, built in 1868, is the oldest building in Wausau's Historical District. This home is also in pristine condition and consists of two separated executive efficiency apartments-suites, each with well thought out themes and modern conveniences such as hot tubs. These suites are especially popular with visiting Rib Mountain hikers and Granite Peak skiers. Located only a few short blocks away from The Leigh Yawkey Woodson Art Museum, The Marathon County Historical Museum, and the Grand Theatre which features live performances on a weekly basis.
